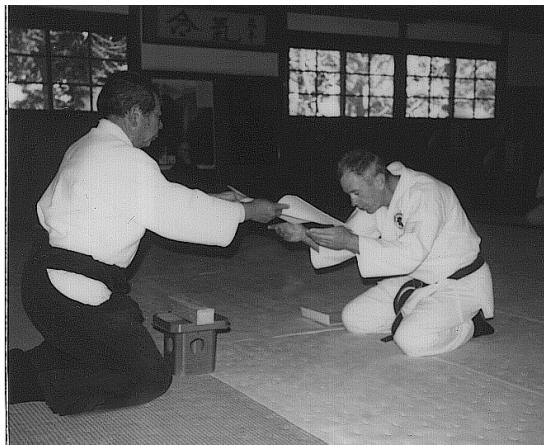
Field Sensei (1947-) studied Aikido under Morihiro Saito Sensei 9th Dan, while living in Japan at the Iwama Dojo 1979 - 1982, April 1987, April 1994, April/May 1995, July 1996 & March 1999. He teaches techniques, both open handed and weapons, as he was taught them by Saito Sensei – O Sensei's technical heir. Field Sensei has been issuing Iwama Ryu Aikido Dan Ranks exclusively in Australia since 1994 when Saito Sensei gave him the sole authority to do so. In the year 2000, during his last seminar in Australia, Saito Soke honoured Michael Field by making him his sole representative for Iwama Ryu Aikido in Australia. [Iwama Ryu Aikido is the Aikido that was taught by O-Sensei (the founder) in Iwama].
